Erasmus+ ICM opportunities

The Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility project coordinated by the University of Trento allows funded mobility of Bachelor, Master and PhD students from the partner universities.

Nomination

Students must be nominated by the Home University after fair and transparent selection.

Mobility period

Mobility for **courses attendance** is up to 5,5 months (min. 2) and is possible in the following periods:

Fall term (September – February): nomination deadline on May, 15th;

Spring term (February-July): nomination deadline on October, 15th;

Mobility for **research purposes (Ba, Ma, PhDs)** (min. 2 months)

staff mobility (minimum 5 days) is possible in any time of the year with a 3-month notice.

NEW

Short mobility for PhDs (5-30 days) + short blended mobility Ba, Ma, PhDs (5-30 days in presence + virtual) **for Summer/Winter Schools + mobility for course attendance** minimum 2 months from ICM 2022 project.

Grant

Long mobility: 850 euro/month grant plus travel contribution up to 1500 € depending on the distance

Short mobility: 79/56 (after 14th day) euro/day plus travel contribution up to 1500 € depending on the distance

Bilateral Agreements mobility

Within the bilateral agreement with the University of Trento, any study or research mobility is admitted and is always available according to the limits stated in the agreement.

Nomination

Students (Bachelor, Master and PhD) must be nominated by the Home University.

Mobility period

Mobility for courses attendance is one semester and is possible in the following terms:

Fall term (September - February): nomination deadline on May, 15th;

Spring term (February-July): nomination deadline on October, 15th;

Mobility for research purposes and staff mobility is possible in any time of the year with a 3-month advice.

Grant

No grants are available from UniTrento. Mobility can be financed by the home University or any other type of grant.

Research activity can also be combined with mobility for attending courses.

Acceptance: nominees' mobility is confirmed only after the Mobility Project approval.
